NEW YORK, August 14, 2013 - La Respuesta, one of Puerto Rico's leading cultural spaces, presents *Los Muros Hablan NYC*, an international urban art and music project from August 19 to 25, 2013 throughout El Barrio. The project features a number of artists from around the world who will be painting various murals in the neighborhood and one in the Bronx, as well as host numerous events open to the public. Participating artists include Axel Void (Spain), Betsy Casañas (Philadelphia), Celso Gonzalez (Puerto Rico), Don Rim X (Puerto Rico), Elian & Pastel (Argentina), Jufe (La Pandilla) (Puerto Rico), L NY (Ecuador), Manny Vega (New York City), and Viajero (New York City). The mural locations will be announced at the **press conference** on **August 19, 2013 at 1:00pm**, to be held in front of Manny Vega's Mural on 105th St. btwn Lex and 3rd Avenues.
